

How to Fix Java Error on MCS-Touchscreen




1. Begin by unlocking your touchscreen to do this Double click on the my computer icon located on your desktop




2. Double click on local disk c




3. Double click on the MCS folder




4. Double click on the Unlock Memory file




5. A black dos prompt will come up and tell you to push any key to continue, just close this window by clicking on the black X on the top right hand corner




6. Now we have to reboot the touchscreen for the unlock to take effect you do this by clicking on the start button on the bottom left hand corner of the screen.




7. Now click on the turn off computer button




8. Then click the restart button




9. Once the touchscreen has restarted you will see the autostart dos prompt. Go ahead and close it.




10. Double click on My Computer.




11. Double click on **Local Disk (C:)**.




12. Double Click on **Documents and Settings**.




13. Double click on **All Users**.




14. Double click on **Start Menu**.




15. Double click on **Programs**.




16. Double click on **Start UP**.



17. In the **Startup** folder there will be a file labeled **hs_err_(xxxx)**. Click on it once to highlight it.




18. Click on **File**.




19. It will prompt "Are you sure you want to delete" click yes.

20. Once you have deleted the Error file double click on the **mystartup** icon.




21. This will run the Auto start program that starts up when the touch screen first boots up.




22. Allow this to run through without clicking on anything until MCS-CONNECT fully loads to the graphics screen without any errors.


23. Now we want to lock the touchscreen back up, to do this go to the desktop and double click on the **My Computer** icon.




24. Double click on **local disk c.**




25. Double click on the **MCS** folder.




26. Double click on the **Lock Memory** file.




27. A black dos prompt will come up and tell you to push any key to continue, just close this window by clicking on the black X on the top right hand corner.
